



## **MUSIC AWARDS POLICY**

### **Certificates of Merit**

Awarded to FP and SP boys in Term 4 on recommendation of individual instrument teachers for good progress or dedication.

### **Badges**

CHOIR / DJEMBE / ORCHESTRA

Awarded to Grade 6 and 7 boys only who have been a member of one or more of the above groups for a minimum of 2 years. Awarded in Term 3.

### **Full Colours**

Awarded in Term 4

Awarded to noticeably outstanding boys in Grade 6 when they have been in the spotlight during Grades 5 and 6

Usually awarded to a small number of Grade 7 boys for having maintained an outstanding record from Grade 4 to Grade 7

Frequent Solo performances at school concerts or Eisteddfods / Music Festivals

Reliable / committed pupil

Favourable to be a member of the choir / djembe group / orchestra

Participated and achieved well in external music exams (ABRSM or TC). At least Grade 3 level required in practical and/or theory.

### **Honours**

Awarded in Term 4

Usually awarded to a Grade 7 boy for exceptional/excellent musical ability

Possible to achieve in Grade 6 for someone exceptional

Confident, reliable soloist

Reliable, committed pupil

Favourable to be a member of choir / djembe group / orchestra

Participated and achieved well in external music exams (ABRSM or TC). At least Grade 4 level required in practical and Grade 3 theory.

More than one musical instrument will be to the pupil's advantage
