

MUSIC AWARDS POLICY

Certificates of Merit

Awarded to FP and SP boys in Term 4 on recommendation of individual teachers for good progress or dedication.

Badges

CHOIR / DJEMBE / ORCHESTRA / MARIMBA

Awarded to Grade 6 and 7 boys who have been a member of one or more of the above groups for a minimum of 2 years. These badges are awarded in Term 3.

Full Colours

- Awarded in Term 2 and Term 4.
- Awarded to noticeably outstanding boys in Grade 7 when they have been in the spotlight during Grades 5 and 6.
- Possible to achieve in Grade 6 for someone exceptional.
- Frequent Solo performances at school concerts or Eisteddfods / Music Festivals.
- Reliable and committed pupil.
- Achieved at least a Grade 3 level in an external practical examination (ABRSM or Trinity College), with a music theory achievement regarded as beneficial.
- Has performed individually at a Highbury music concert in the area in which the Grade 3 level was achieved.

Honours

- Awarded in Term 2 and Term 4.
- Usually awarded to a Grade 7 boy for exceptional/excellent musical ability.
- Possible to achieve in Grade 6 for someone exceptional.
- Confident, reliable soloist.
- Reliable, committed pupil.
- Favourable to be a member off choir / djembe / orchestra / marimba.
- Achieved at least a Grade 4 level or higher in an external practical examination (ABRSM or Trinity College), with a music theory achievement regarded as beneficial.
- More than one musical instrument will be to the pupil's advantage.

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
